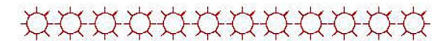

Rules and Regulations

1. Each team will have no more than six members.
2. Teams are responsible for their own work area, to include final clean- up .
The team must provide their own pot, utensils, and gas burner.
Electricity is available; please identify on registration form need for electricity.
Be creative with your cooking area; you may decorate it anyway you like as long as it is not offensive, inappropriate, or political.
3. All teams are responsible for providing their own tent/cover, table and chairs.
4. No off site cooking of Chili. It must be prepared on-site during the challenge.
No ingredients may be precooked or treated in, any way prior to the event.
All Ingredients must be prepared in view of spectators.
5. Each team must have a thermometer. Chili is to be kept at 140 degrees fahrenheit or above at all times.
6. Each team will wear hand gloves for food preparation and for serving.
For the purpose of tasting and selling chili by the bowl and the quart each team must cook 4 gallons of chili.
7. Have fun and enjoy the day. This event will benefit Remembrance on the River, Wounded Warriors and Gold Star Families in our community.
